Silverstone Road, Dadford

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980, The Highways (Road Hump) Regulations 1999 and all other enabling powers in conjunction with the developer MEPC Silverstone GP Ltd proposes to construct a round top road hump in the publicly maintained section of Silverstone Road, Dadford.

The road hump in the publicly maintained highway is to be constructed (3.7m in length, 75mm max height) at the following location:

- (i) At a point approx. 20 metres South of the Northern most junction of North Hill and Silverstone Road.

A copy of the plan showing the road to be affected and the location of the Road Hump may be inspected by appointment during normal office hours at Walton Street Offices, Aylesbury.
