Proposed Traffic Calming Scheme, Flat Top Road Hump – Rutland Street, High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980 and all other enabling powers that Buckinghamshire Council in conjunction with Inland Homes Developments No2 Ltd are undertaking a statutory consultation for the introduction of a Flat Top Road Hump along Rutland Street, High Wycombe in compliance with planning permission 16/08306/FUL.

The scheme will be constructed and fully funded by Inland Homes Developments No2 Ltd. These works will consist of a Flat Top Road Hump (approximately 43.50m in length, 75mm high and with a gradient of 1:16) on Rutland Street which will be located approx. 6.75m South of Desborough Road junction. These works will be carried out under a Section 278 Agreement. I enclose a copy of the site notice and plans.

The Council will notify the appropriate Chief Officer of Thames Valley Police of this intention.
