### **Proposed Traffic Calming Build Out – Station Road, Quainton**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 4 of the Highway Traffic Calming Regulations 1999 and Section 90G of the Highways Act 1980, that Buckinghamshire Council in conjunction with Barwood Homes are undertaking a consultation for the introduction of a Build Out on Station Road, Quainton in compliance with planning application 17/04041/AOP. The build out will enable the adjacent footway to be widened to 1.5m.

The Build Out will be constructed and funded by Barwood Homes as part of their wider Highway Works. These works are to construct a new site access with dropped kerbs and tactile paving for pedestrians and accessibility improvements to the existing bus stop to the North of 151 Station Road to include a new uncontrolled tactile crossing point.

These works will be carried out under a Section 278 Agreement. We enclose a copy of the site notice and plan.

The Council will notify the appropriate Chief Officer of Thames Valley Police of this intention.
