In accordance with Regulation 21 of the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended), anyone who has submitted a response to the consultation has a right to request to be heard by the examiner. Such a request must be made in writing before the end of this consultation on 24 May 2026.

Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified (at a specified address) of any of the following:

- that the Draft CIL Charging Schedule has been submitted to the Examiner in accordance with section 212 of the Planning Act 2008;
- the publication of the recommendations of the Examiner and the reasons for those recommendations; and
- the approval of the CIL Charging Schedule by the charging authority.

Any person who has made representations about the Draft CIL Charging Schedule may withdraw those representations at any time by giving notice in writing to the Council either by e-mail or by post at the addresses given above.
