Overview

We want to hear the views of local residents and organisations on the Neighbourhood Plan for Little Missenden.

In October 2022, the Parish of Little Missenden was designated a neighbourhood area by Buckinghamshire Council. This followed an application by Little Missenden Parish Council.

Little Missenden Parish Council has now completed a period of local community engagement on the Little Missenden Neighbourhood Plan and have submitted the final version to us.

The next stage of the process is for us, as the local authority, to carry out a public consultation on the submitted plan.

This is the final opportunity for local people to comment on the plan before it goes to independent examination.

The Little Missenden Neighbourhood Plan includes policies to shape local development to:

- protect rural character, landscape features, and biodiversity
- designate strategic buffer zones
- introduce design codes
- promote energy and water-efficient buildings
- influence housing mix

- protect the conservation area and designate local heritage assets
- retain and improve community facilities, recreation spaces, and local services
- designate local green spaces
- support local businesses, agriculture, and homeworking infrastructure
- influence parking provision and improve travel networks

What happens next

Following consultation, we will collate the responses and submit them to an independent examiner.

The examiner will consider public comments and ensure the plan meets the basic conditions in the Localism Act and other relevant regulations.

If the plan passes independent examination, the next stage is a local referendum to see whether it has community support.

If the neighbourhood plan is supported, we will adopt it as part of local planning policy to assess planning applications in the Neighbourhood Area.
