speed limit to 40mph**

### **Statutory Consultation for the reduction of existing 50mph Speed Limit to 40mph on A40 London Road, Beaconsfield**

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing the reduction of speed limit from 50mph to 40 mph on A40 London Road, between Holtspur Roundabout in an easterly direction towards the existing 30mph terminal signs on Wycombe End, covering a length of approximately 1.25 miles. This is to reduce the risk and severity of collisions and improve safety on the A40 London Road.
