STATUTORY CONSULTATION

The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No.* 202*)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to reduce the existing speed limit from 40mph to 30mph on the following roads:

- A4128 Wycombe Road, Prestwood From a point 76 metres south of the junction with Lodge Lane in a southerly direction to a point 70 metres south of the junction with Peterley Lane and Perks Lane.
- Peterley Lane, Prestwood From its junction with A4128 Wycombe Road and Perks Lane in an easterly direction for a length of 26 metres.
