Statutory Consultation for the introduction of a 30mph Speed Limit Traffic Regulation Order within the new Arabella Park Development in Little Kimble

Buckinghamshire Council are proposing to introduce a 30mph speed limit Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) within the new Arabella Park development off Kimblewick Road in Little Kimble. This will include the installation of terminal signs as you enter the development, with repeaters where appropriate and the works will be funded by the developer (i.e., TRO legal work, signing and lining works).

We will develop the proposals based on what residents and key stakeholders within the area tell us. If the feedback shows people support the proposal, we will begin the process of implementing the proposed speed limit, and we will update you again to confirm the proposal.
