

# STATUTORY CONSULTATION

The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and  
(On-Street Parking Places) Order 2021 (Amendment No.\*) Order 202\*  
The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No. \*) Order

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the Orders – to facilitate the passage of vehicular traffic on Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden, is to introduce new double yellow lines and extend the existing 30mph speed limit, as detailed below:

- **Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden** – Extension of Double Yellow Lines on the eastern side of the carriageway from the existing lines in a north–westerly direction to the A413 Junction for a length of 225.54 metres.
- **Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden** - Introduction of new double yellow lines from the property edge of the Public House on the western side of the carriageway in a north–westerly direction to the A413 Junction for a length of 202.42 metres. This section also includes the entrance to Town End Farm.
- **Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden** - Extension to the existing 30mph speed limit north from the entrance to Town End Farm in a north–westerly direction for a length of 80 metres, ending outside Havenfield Cottage.
