The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No *) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders is to introduce and extend parking restrictions (double yellow lines) and to extend the existing 30mph speed limit on Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden.

Road Name (And Extents)	What is being proposed
Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden (From The Black Horse Public House to A413 junction)	Extension of Double Yellow Lines on the eastern side of the carriageway from the existing lines in a north—westerly direction to the A413 Junction for a length of 225.54 metres. Introduce new double yellow lines from the property edge of the Public House on the western side of the carriageway in a north—westerly direction to the A413 Junction for a length of 202.42 metres. This section also includes the entrance to Town End Farm.
Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden (From Town End Farm to A413 junction)	Extension to the existing 30mph speed limit north from the entrance to Town End Farm in a north–westerly direction for a length of 80 metres, ending outside Havenfield Cottage.
