

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden - Traffic Regulation Orders

It is proposed to introduce new and extend the existing Double Yellow Line restrictions on Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden. In addition, it is proposed to extend the current 30mph speed limit.

The table below identifies proposed changes to restrictions for the street named and the reasons for proposing the restrictions.

Road Name and Extents	Proposed Restrictions	Reasons
Aylesbury Road, Great Missenden (From a point c. 21.3 metres south of The Black Horse Public House in a north–westerly direction to the A413 junction)	Extension of Double Yellow Lines on the eastern side of the carriageway from the existing lines in a north–westerly direction to the A413 Junction for a length of 225.54 metres.	Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 3 (Restrictions on traffic regulation orders), Subsection 2d: “for facilitating the passage of vehicular traffic on the road [...]”
	Introduction of new double yellow lines from the property edge of the Public House on the western side of the carriageway in a north–westerly direction to the A413 Junction for a length of 202.42 metres. This section also includes the entrance to Town End Farm.	
	Extension to the existing 30mph speed limit north from the entrance to Town End Farm in a north–westerly direction, for a length of 80 metres, ending outside Havenfield Cottage.
