

STATUTORY CONSULTATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council, as the local highway authority, proposes to introduce a signal-controlled toucan crossing on B4009 Lower Icknield Way, Longwick, approximately 12m northeast of the existing informal crossing, together with the widening and conversion of existing footways into shared-use pedestrian and cycle facility, and the construction of new connecting shared-use facility linking to the proposed toucan crossing at the Sportsman Roundabout, Longwick, in accordance with Section 23 and Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Sections 65 and 66 of the Highways Act 1980.
