The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No 000*) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to reduce the current 40mph to a proposed 30mph speed limit, from the junction with Penn Green (existing change from 30mph to 40mph) for approximately 2km to a point just west of Clay Street.
