### **Statutory Consultation for the implementation of a Raised Table with Zebra and Cycle Crossing, and Shared - Use Pedestrian and Cycle Paths, on Turnfurlong Lane, within the Bedgrove Park area**

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing to upgrade an existing uncontrolled pedestrian crossing point on Turnfurlong Lane, Aylesbury, near the junction with Camborne Avenue. We are also proposing to convert a number of existing pedestrian footways in the Bedgrove Park area to shared – use footways. This project has been allocated funding from Homes England to improve Aylesbury’s active travel infrastructure and has been identified in the Aylesbury Garden Town Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP).
