(BROUGHTON LANE AND STOCKLAKE (PARTS), BIERTON)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2020

STATEMENT OF REASONS

During the construction of a new housing development in Bierton, there are carriageways that have been realigned. Buckinghamshire Council proposes that these sections of highway are to be subject to a Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Order.

Under Section 1(1) of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** the specified reasons for considering this change are:-

1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of such danger arising.
2. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

The Department for Transport Circular 01/2013 'Setting local speed limits' sets out how speed limits should be assessed.
