BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (BROUGHTON LANE AND STOCKLAKE (PARTS), BIERTON) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2020

STATEMENT OF REASONS

During the construction of a new housing development in Bierton, there are carriageways that have been realigned. Buckinghamshire Council proposes that these sections of highway are to be subject to a Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Order.

Under Section 1(1) of the **Road Traffic Regulation** Act 1984 the specified reasons for considering this change are:-

- 1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of such danger arising.
- 2. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

The Department for Transport Circular 01/2013 'Setting local speed limits' sets out how speed limits should be assessed.
