# Statutory Consultation for the implementation of two Raised Zebra Crossings at locations along High Street and Deanway, Chalfont St Giles

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing to introduce raised highway tables to two existing Zebra Crossings in Chalfont St Giles, along High Street and Deanway. A raised highway table is proposed to enhance the safety of pedestrians by delivering a localised reduction in the speed of motorised vehicles. Due to the suburban and residential setting of the proposed crossings within the village centre, the scheme seeks to benefit residents crossing at this location.
