

PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT A RAISED TABLE AT THE EXISTING ZEBRA CROSSING

DEANWAY - Chalfont St. Giles

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 90A – 90F of the Highways Act 1980, The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 and after consultation with the Chief of Police, proposes to construct a raised table in the publicly maintained section of Deanway, Chalfont St. Giles. The location of the proposed Raised Table is as follows;

- At a point approximately 24.3 metres from the Milton Hill junction; and
- At a point approximately 20 metres from the Hillside Close junction.



The Raised Table proposal is to improve the safety for pedestrians wishing to cross Deanway using the new facilities, with drivers encouraged to approach at a reduced speed. The suburban and residential setting, and the proximity to commercial sites adjacent, the scheme seeks to benefit local residents and shoppers, when crossing at this location.
