



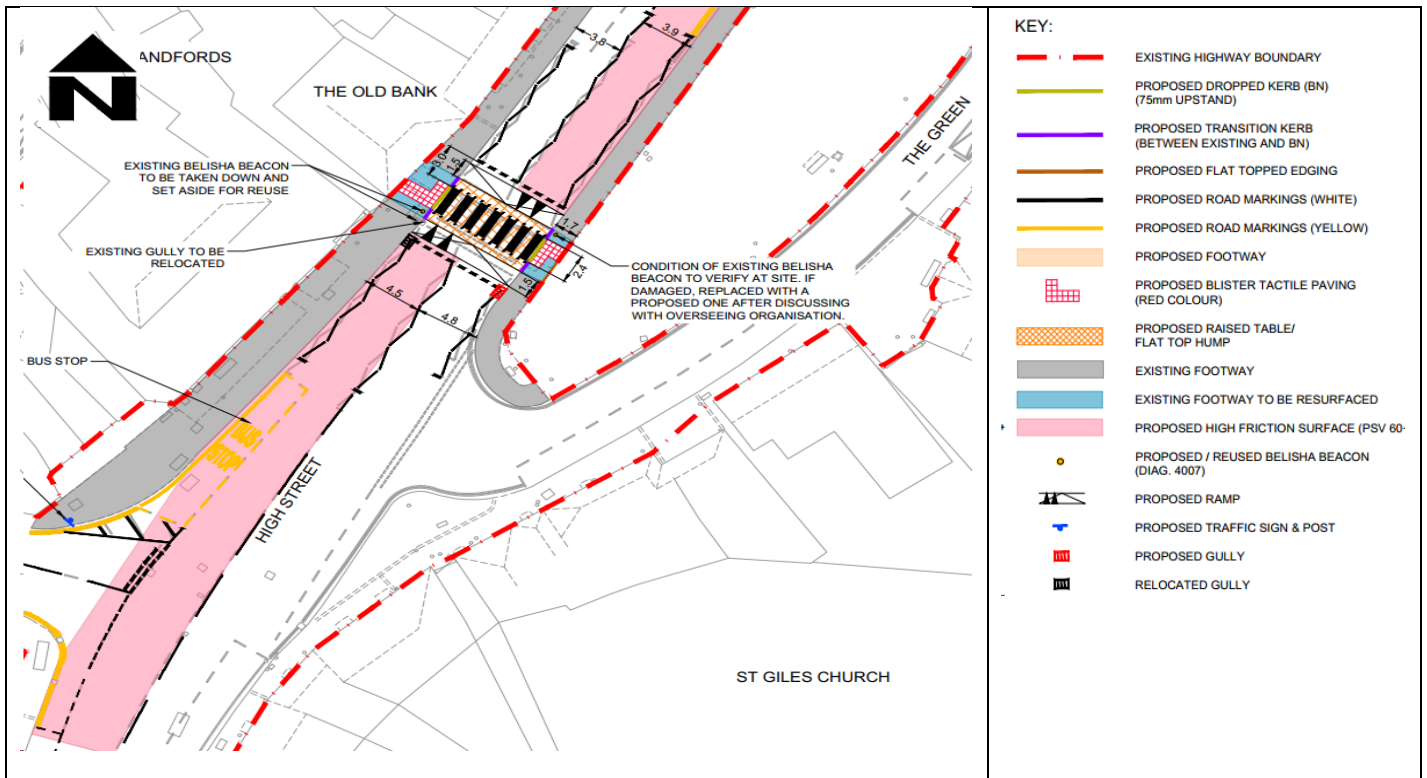
## PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT A RAISED TABLE AT THE EXISTING ZEBRA CROSSING

### HIGH STREET - Chalfont St. Giles

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 90A – 90F of the Highways Act 1980, The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 and after consultation with the Chief of Police, proposes to construct a raised table in the publicly maintained section of High Street, Chalfont St. Giles.

The location of the proposed Raised Table is as follows;

- At a point approximately 15 metres from The Green junction; and
- At a point approximately 36.5 metres from the Up Corner junction.



The Raised Table proposal is to improve the safety for pedestrians wishing to cross High Street using the new facilities, with drivers encouraged to approach at a reduced speed. The suburban and residential setting, and the proximity to commercial sites within the village centre, the scheme seeks to benefit local residents and shoppers, when crossing at this location.
