Dear Resident,

Statutory Consultation for the Introduction of a 30mph Speed Limit on Cheddington Road, Pitstone

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing to introduce a 30mph speed limit on Cheddington Road from the railway bridge to the property 'Autumn Leaves' (where there is street lighting). Buckinghamshire Council has been made aware of speeding issues and have noticed that there is no Order currently present, thereby making the existing speed limit 60mph (i.e., National Speed Limit). This proposal is aimed to maintain the consistency of the posted speed limit (30mph) along the entire length of Cheddington Road to allow Thames Valley Police to enable lawful speed limit enforcement.

We will develop the proposals based on what residents and key stakeholders within the area tell us. If the feedback shows people support the proposal, we will begin the process of implementing these restrictions, and we will update you again to confirm the proposal.
