## The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) Order 2021 (Amendment No \*) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to introduce new Disabled Bays in Fulmer, Burnham and Beaconsfield. This will also include the Unrestricted Bays and Double Yellow Lines in Denham, as listed below.
