Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to introduce various parking restrictions across multiple roads in the Elm Farm Estate, Aylesbury as shown below:

No Waiting Mon – Sat 8am – 10pm	Elm Farm Road and Waivers Way
No Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 5pm On Entrance Markings	Hazelhurst Drive
