The effect of the above proposed Order will be removal of 15 no of trees on Eskdale Avenue, Chesham. Location of the trees are as follows,

Trees nearby house no. 1, 27, 32, 34, 43, 55, 60, 88, 90, 103, 105, 109, 122A, 127 and near Chesham Eskdale Avenue bus stop (1 - west bound).
