The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping), (On - Street Parking Places) Order 2021 (Amendment No 00*) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the above proposed order is for the introduction and amendment of parking and loading restrictions on various streets in Gerrards Cross as detailed below:

Gaviots Green, Dukes Wood Avenue, Dukes Lane entrance and West Common Road- No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – *to be effective* 24 hours a day, 7 days a week).

Fulmer Way - Increase the waiting period from 1 hour to 2 hours i.e “Limited Waiting 2 hrs No Return Within 4 hrs”.

Marsham Way - Removal of the existing “No Waiting at Any Time” restriction (double yellow lines) and introduction of “Limited Waiting 1 hr No Return Within 2 hrs”; Increase the Limited Waiting period from 1 hour to 2 hours and the no return period from 1 hour to 4 hours i.e “Limited Waiting 2 hrs No Return Within 4 hrs” and No loading at Any Time (Double Blips - *to be effective* 24 hours a day, 7 days a week).

Bulstrode Way - No loading at Any Time (Double Blips - *to be effective* 24 hours a day, 7 days a week); Removal of existing access marking between the parking bays and introduction of “No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – *to be effective* 24 hours a day, 7 days a week)” and Adjustments to the extent of parking bays along Bulstrode Way.

South Park View - Removal of the existing “No Waiting at Any Time” restriction (double yellow lines).

Vicarage Way - Increase the Limited Waiting period from 1 hour to 2 hours and the no return period from 1 hour to 4 hours i.e. “Limited Waiting 2 hrs No Return Within 4 hrs”
