### **Statutory Consultation for the proposed 40mph Speed Limit on Great Horwood Road, Winslow**

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing to implement a 40mph speed limit on Great Horwood Road, Winslow, from the uncontrolled crossing at the junction with A413 Buckingham Road to farm entrance gate southeast of Roddimore Farm, covering an approximate distance of 445m.
