

STATUTORY CONSULTATION

The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No *) Order 202* The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) Order 2021 (Amendment No *) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a number of Traffic Regulation Orders under Sections 84(1), (2) and (3), 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 in Aylesbury and Stoke Mandeville, as part of the South East Aylesbury Link Road and High Speed Rail 2 works.

- **Lower Road, Stoke Mandeville** (On new road stub north of the B4443 Lower Road roundabout, outside the 'Elmfield' property) – Introduce Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting at Any Time)
- **Lower Road, Stoke Mandeville** (On new road stub south-east of the B4443 Lower Road roundabout, between No 28 and No. 18) - Introduce Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting at Any Time)
- **Lower Road, Stoke Mandeville** (On new road stub south-east of the B4443 Lower Road roundabout, outside No. 10 and No. 8) - Introduce Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting at Any Time)
- **Lower Road, Stoke Mandeville** (From a point approximately 20 metres southeast from the junction with Beethoven Drive in a southeasterly direction towards the existing 30mph speed terminal signs near No. 67 Lower Road) – Reduce existing 40mph speed limit down to 30mph
- **Lower Road, Stoke Mandeville** (Between No. 67 and No. 3A) – Revoke existing 30mph Traffic Order (speed limit will remain 30mph by virtue of street lighting)
- **A4010** (West of B4443 Lower Road roundabout) – Introduce a 40mph speed limit order and new cycleways
- **A4010** (Between B4443 Lower Road Roundabout and A413 Wendover Roundabout) – Introduce a 40mph speed limit order and new cycleways
- **A4010** (East of A413 Wendover Roundabout) – Introduce a 40mph speed limit order
- **A413 Wendover Roundabout** (including approaches) – Introduce a 30mph speed limit order and new cycleways
- **A413 Wendover Road** (Opposite County Farm Cottages) – New Bus Stop
- **A4010** (Whole length of Link Road) – Introduce a Clearway (No Stopping on Main Carriageway)
