The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) Order 2021 (Amendment No 00*) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to introduced waiting restriction (double yellow line and single yellow line) on Baker Street and School Lane, Waddesdon as listed below:

Table 1- Road extents and proposed parking restrictions on Baker Street, Waddesdon

Road Name	What are we proposing?
Baker Street, Waddesdon	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week)
School Lane, Waddesdon	
Baker Street, Waddesdon	No Waiting between 7:30am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:30pm (Single Yellow Line with school time restriction)
