The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) Order 2021 (Amendment No 00*) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the above Order is to introduced parking restrictions (double yellow line and single yellow line) on Baker Street and School Lane, Waddesdon as listed below:

Baker Street, Waddesdon - No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week) and No Waiting between 7:30am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:30pm (Single Yellow Line with school time restriction).

School Lane, Waddesdon - No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week)
