### **Statutory Consultation for the introduction of traffic island on Edgcott Road near the Cotswold Way junction, Calvert Green.**

Buckinghamshire Highways is proposing to introduce a traffic island on Edgcott Road near the Cotswold Way junction to improve road safety by reducing collision risk and managing vehicle conflicts at the junction, particularly for the right - turning movements.
