Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a priority narrowing (Build out) under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a priority narrowing on Preston Road, Gawcott as shown below:
