HS2 TRANCHE 3: STEEPLE CLAYDON TRAFFIC CALMING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a statutory consultation under Sections 122 of the Road Regulation Act 1984, (as amended).

Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce traffic calming measures (build out, 75mm high speed cushions and 75mm high raised table junction) under The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999, to be located on Addison Road, Steeple Claydon.

The effect of the above proposed order will be to introduce traffic calming measures on the following roads:

Addison Road, Steeple Claydon

- Priority narrowing (build out), approximately 133m south (near house number 10) of the Willowvale Way and Addison road junction
- A pair of speed cushions, approximately 80m north of the Willowvale Way and Addison road junction and one speed cushion with proposed build out

Willowvale Way and Addison Road Junction – 75mm raised table
