## **The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No \*) Order 202\***

**Notice is hereby given** that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to remove Traffic Regulation Order for 30mph speed limit in Steeple Claydon, as shown below:
