

STATUTORY CONSULTATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to convert sections of existing footway to shared use pedestrian and cycle facilities under Section 65(1) of the Highways Act 1980.

The proposed conversions are located at the following locations:

- The Parkway – Opposite No. 268 towards a point adjacent to property No. 170, for approximately 21 metres.
- Church Road - From No. 170 The Parkway in a north-easterly direction towards the roundabout with Thornbridge Road (on the westerly footway for approximately 146 metres)
- Thornbridge Road – From the roundabout with Church Road to No.9A (on the southern footway for approximately 32 metres)
