

# STATUTORY CONSULTATION

The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) Order 2021 (Amendment No.\* 202\*)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 122(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Buckinghamshire Council also proposes to introduce a new 75 – millimetre high raised table crossing under Sections 90(A), (1a), (C) and (D) of the Highways Act 1980, to be located on Warren Wood Drive, approximately 16 metres west from the junction with Keep Hill Drive and Lime Avenue, High Wycombe.

The effect of the above proposed Order will to be extend the existing Double Yellow Lines on the following road:

- **Warren Wood Drive, High Wycombe** – From the existing Double Yellow Lines on the southern side of the carriageway, just west of the junction with Keep Hill Drive and Lime Avenue, in a westerly direction for approximately 14.3 metres.
