STATEMENT OF REASONS

Maxwell Road, Beaconsfield TROs

It is proposed to introduce prohibition of 'right turn' restrictions and amend parking restrictions on Maxwell Road, Beaconsfield which relate to planning consents granted for a new residential development.

The table below identifies proposed changes to restrictions for the streets named and the reasons for proposing the restrictions.
