restrictions/speed amendment

Dear Resident /Business owner,

Statutory Consultation for the Introduction/Amendment of Existing Waiting Restrictions and the amendment to the existing Speed Limit Traffic Regulation Order on Osier Way, Buckingham, near the Swan Business Park.

Buckinghamshire Highways is proposing to extend the existing Waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) and introduce un-restricted bays on Osier Way, serving Swan Business Park and the adjacent residential development under construction. In addition, we are proposing an amendment to the existing 40mph speed limit to accommodate the new junction serving the northern development, as well as the entrance to the southern development.

The proposed extension of the waiting restrictions is intended to ensure that the access road to Swan Business Park remains clear and unobstructed and to maintain visibility at the realigned junction serving the business park.

The proposed speed limit amendment will help ensure that the speed limit remains appropriate for the changing road environment. Together, these measures will improve safety for motorists, pedestrians and other road users by reducing inappropriate parking and supporting safer vehicle speeds at key access points.
