THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT No. **) ORDER 202*

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (SPEED LIMIT) (AMENDMENT No.) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make two Traffic Regulation Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

It is proposed to introduce the following restrictions:

- Double Yellow Lines along Osier Way (including the junctions), Angelica Way (junctions with Bayberry Close and Cicely Road) and the western entrance to the northern development (junction with Gawcott Road – exact route to be confirmed).
- Unrestricted Bays on Osier Way (opposite junction with Swan Business Park).
- Bus Stops on Angelica Way – western-bound opposite No. 58 and eastbound outside No. 60.
- Amend the existing 40mph speed limit to accommodate the new junction serving the northern development, as well as the entrance to the southern development.
