THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING, AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT 00*) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce several parking restrictions through a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 32 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), which is to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic including pedestrians.

It is also proposed to introduce traffic calming measures under Sections 90A, B, C and D of the Highways Act 1980 on Arnison Avenue and Hillview Road outside Portland House, High Wycombe.

Marlow - West Street (From the zigzags to the roundabout – both sides), High Street (From the roundabout to outside No. 12 – western side), High Street (From the roundabout to outside No. 7 – eastern side), High Street (On the Southeastern Traffic Island), Spittal Street (From the Roundabout to just past the junction with Dukes Place), Spittal Street (From the Roundabout to just past the junction with Morris Place)	"No Loading Mon-Sat 8am-9.30am and 12pm-2pm and Mon-Sat 4.30pm-6pm" TO BE AMENDED TO "No Loading at Any Time"

Marlow - Quoiting Square (In – Front only)	“Payment Parking Place 7am-7pm 24hrs No Return Within 11hrs” & “Permit Holders Only ML2” TO BE REMOVED
Marlow - Wethered Road (from junction with Trinity Road in an easterly direction to a point 1 metre past the church entrance)	Add newly painted Double Yellow Lines to Traffic Regulation Order
Chalfont St. Giles - High Street (outside Chalfont Barber Lounge)	Introduce new Disabled Bay AND reduce extents of ‘Limited Waiting Mon – Sat 8am – 6pm 1hr Within 1hr’ to accommodate new disabled bay
