NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce Traffic Regulation Orders under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of Part I, Sections 81, 82, 83, and 84 of Part VI, and Part IV of schedule 9, Section 23, and Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and Section 65(1) of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the above proposed Orders is for the introduction of signal-controlled toucan crossing, conversion and widening of pedestrian footway into shared use pedestrian and cycle facility, speed limit reduction from 40mph to 30mph and No Waiting at Any Time parking restrictions at the junction between Pinewood Road and Pinewood Green, Iver.
