STATEMENT OF REASONS

Pinewood Road Toucan Crossing, Iver

It is proposed to introduce a signal-controlled toucan crossing on Pinewood Road, speed limit reduction from 40 mph to 30 mph from north of Pinewood Road / Pinewood studios to south of Pinewood Road / Pinewood Green junction and no waiting at any time restriction on Pinewood Green Junction with Pinewood Road, Iver.

The proposals can be found in the table below, along with the reasons for these proposals.

Pinewood Road (near junction with Pinewood Green)	Signal-Controlled Crossing	For ensuring legal enforceability and consistency in accordance with Part I, Part VI, section 23 and section 122 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. These proposals have been put forward to resolve the issues of inadequate pedestrian and cyclist crossing facilities on Pinewood Road, high traffic volumes and speeds during peak times, and congestion caused by short car trips between Pinewood Studios and the Iver Heath retail area. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
Pinewood Green Junction with Pinewood Road	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week)	
Pinewood Road, Iver (from north of the Pinewood Studios / Pinewood Road Roundabout to south of the Pinewood Road / Pinewood Green priority junction)	Reducing the speed limit from 40mph to 30mph for the proposed length of circa. 820 meters	
Pinewood Green (approaching the junction with Pinewood Road on the northern footway)	Conversion of existing footway to a pedestrian and shared-use path [See Schedule 1 below]	The conversion has been proposed as part of the scheme's aims in linking the shared-use path with the proposed Iver Cycleway.
Pinewood Green (approaching the junction with Pinewood Road on the southern footway)		Under Section 65 of the Highways Act 1980, Local Authorities can create these paths by converting the footway within the highway.

SCHEDULE 1

Proposed Footway Conversion to Pedestrian and Shared Use Paths

Pinewood Green, Iver

On the northern footway, from the property boundary of No. 178 Pinewood Green and property 'Lyne Eves', to the front of the Lynes Eves property on Pinewood Road, for a length of approximately 29 metres.

On the southern footway, from the western side of the property 'Baney' to the 'give way' lines at the junction with Pinewood Road, for a length of approximately 26 metres.
