

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT 00*) ORDER 202*

It is proposed to introduce restrictions on those lengths of road below, all which make up part of Aylesbury's Platinum Way Cycleway, between Waddesdon and Aylesbury Town Centre, as well as National Cycle Network Route 50.

The table below identifies the proposed changes to restrictions for the streets named and the reasons for proposing the restriction.

<u>Road name</u>	<u>Restrictions</u>	<u>Reasons</u>
Stubble Hill	At the Junction – No Waiting at Any Time (<i>to be effective at all times – 24 hours a day / 7 days a week</i>).	For improving the visibility for those crossing the junction, allowing them to see oncoming traffic more easily.
Long Leys		Pedestrians and cyclists will be better seen by drivers, reducing the risk of accidents.
Mill Meadow		For preventing the use of the road by motorised traffic of a kind which, or its use by motorised traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.
