NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce Double Yellow Lines through a Traffic Regulation Order under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), which is to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic including pedestrians:

- Pegasus Way (junction with Tibbs Road)
- Tibbs Road (on both sides, from Pegasus Way to property No. 22)

In addition, Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following roads in Ickford under Sections 81 and 82 of the aforementioned Act:

- Poplar Way and Willow Lane (whole length)
