

STATUTORY CONSULTATION

The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) and Order 2021 (Amendment No.* 202*)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce Traffic Regulation Orders under Section 122 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Buckinghamshire Council also proposes to introduce a new 75 millimetre high raised table crossing under Sections 90A-90F of the Highways Act 1980, to be located on Woodside Road and Plantation Road in junction with Woodside Road, Amersham.

The effect of the above proposed Order for the amendment of parking restrictions and introduction of raised crossings at A4154 Woodside Road and Plantation Road as detailed below:

Woodside Road (In the vicinity of 193 Stockbridge) - Proposed raised controlled zebra crossing, **Woodside Road (Outside House no. 88)** - Existing controlled zebra crossing to be upgraded as raised controlled zebra crossing, **Plantation Road junction with Woodside Road** - Uncontrolled crossing with flat top hump, **Woodside Road (in an easterly direction from outside No.160-162) & (In a westerly direction from Acre wood nursery school)** - Revocation (Removal) of “No Waiting at Any Time” (Double Yellow Lines – 24/7), **Woodside Road (in an easterly direction from outside No.164-168) & (In a westerly direction from outside No.191-193) & (in an easterly direction from outside No.84) & (In a westerly direction from outside No.119)** - Revocation (Removal) of “No Waiting between Monday and Friday between the hours of 11am and 12pm” (Single Yellow Line), **Plantation Road junction with Woodside Road** – Proposal of “No Waiting at Any Time” (Double Yellow Lines – 24/7)
