The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) Order 202* (Amendment No *) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Highways Act 1980 (Sections 90A-90F).

The effect of the Order is to resolve the recurring collision issues on A4154 Woodside Road. To address these issues, several proposals have been made and are listed below:

Road Name	Type of Proposal
Woodside Road (In the vicinity of 193 Stockbridge)	Proposed raised controlled zebra crossing
Woodside Road (Outside House no. 88)	Existing controlled zebra crossing to be upgraded as raised controlled zebra crossing
Plantation Road junction with Woodside Road	Uncontrolled crossing with flat top hump
Woodside Road (in an easterly direction from outside No.160-162) & (In a westerly direction from Acre wood nursery school)	Revocation (Removal) of No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – 24/7)
Woodside Road (in an easterly direction from outside No.164-168) & (In a westerly direction from outside No.191-193) & (in an easterly direction from outside No.84) & (In a westerly direction from outside No.119)	Revocation (Removal) of No Waiting between Monday and Friday between the hours of 11am and 12pm (Single Yellow Line)
Plantation Road junction with Woodside Road	Proposal of No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – 24/7)
