

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Proposal of Pedestrian Crossings on A4154 Woodside Road

To address the recurring collision issues on A4154 Woodside Road, proposal has been made to enhance safety in this area.

The table below consists of the proposals and the Road name on which the proposal is being made.

Road Name	Type of Proposal	Reasons for Proposal
Woodside Road (In the vicinity of 193 Stockbridge)	Proposed raised controlled zebra crossing	For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
Woodside Road (Outside House no. 88)	Existing controlled zebra crossing to be upgraded as raised controlled zebra crossing	
Plantation Road junction with Woodside Road	Uncontrolled crossing with flat top hump	
Woodside Road (in an easterly direction from outside No.160-162) & (In a westerly direction from Acre wood nursery school)	Revocation (Removal) of No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – 24/7)	For ensuring legal enforceability and consistency in accordance with Part VI of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Sections 90A – 90F of the Highways Act 1980.
Woodside Road (in an easterly direction from outside No.164-168) & (In a westerly direction from outside No.191-193) & (in an easterly direction from outside No.84) & (In a westerly direction from outside No.119)	Revocation (Removal) of No Waiting between Monday and Friday between the hours of 11am and 12pm (Single Yellow Line)	For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (Including pedestrians).
Plantation Road junction with Woodside Road	Proposal of No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – 24/7)	For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
