The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No 00*) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following roads within the 'Rose Farm' development, off Thame Road, Longwick:

Road Name	What are we proposing?
Crown Way, Cowslip Court, Snowdrop Close and Primrose Close (whole lengths)	Introduction of 30mph Speed Limit
