### **Russet Street/ Worcester Street, Berryfields, Aylesbury – Prohibition of Motor Vehicles – Statutory Consultation**

Transport for Buckinghamshire has been commissioned by Buckinghamshire Council to introduce a prohibition of motor vehicles restriction on Russet Street northwest of the Gilliflower Street junction. This will create a quieter and safer environment for pedestrians and cyclists along Russet Street and Worcester Street and could encourage residents to undertake more local journeys on foot or on a bike.

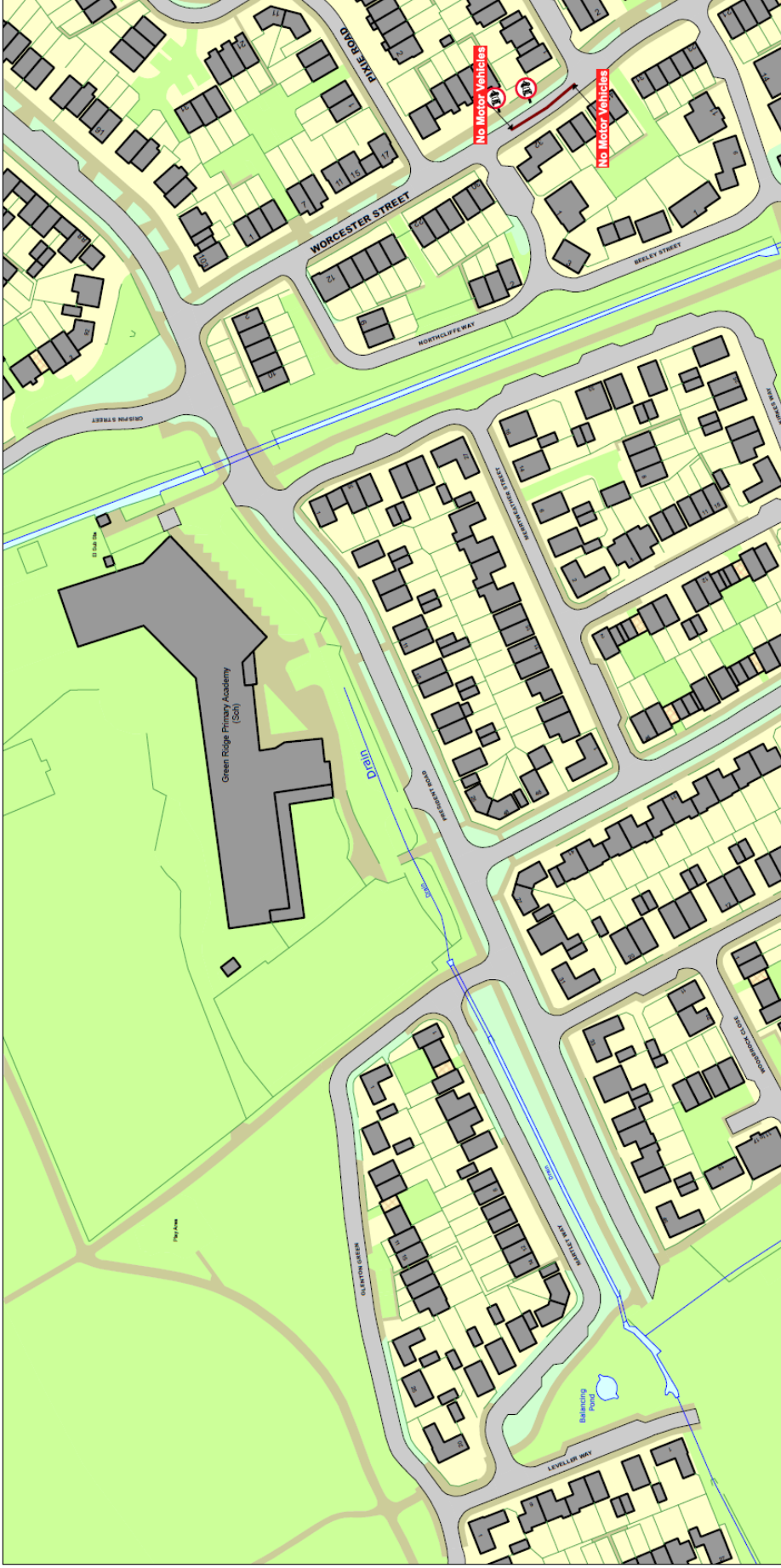
#### **What happens next?**

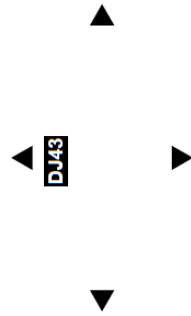
