





## **STATUTORY CONSULTATION**

The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) and Order 2021 (Amendment No.\* 202\*)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce Traffic Regulation Orders under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the above proposed Order is for the introduction of Double Yellow Lines on South Park Drive, Gerrards Cross as detailed below:

**SOUTH PARK DRIVE (between No.10 and No.18) -** Proposed 'No Waiting at any time' (Double Yellow Lines) for a length of approximately 101 metres.
