Consultation for the introduction or amendment of restrictions at various locations across High Wycombe Town Centre and South Park Drive, Gerrards Cross.

Buckinghamshire Highways is proposing revocation of some existing restrictions and amendment or introduction of new restrictions at various locations across High Wycombe and Gerrards Cross.

These changes aim to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
