THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT NO *) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order is to introduce various parking restrictions across multiple roads around St Louis School, Harris Court, Aylesbury as shown below:

Proposed Restriction	Affected Roads
Double yellow lines and 7am - 7pm clearway for the existing bus stop	Bates Court, Bryanston Avenue, Cheney Way, Clarke Court, Dormer Court, Harris Court, Hopkins Court & Orchard Way
Double yellow line junction protection; and single yellow line 'No waiting Monday - Friday 8am-10am and 2pm - 4pm'	Cousins Drive, Honour Close, Matthews Close & Viscount Close
Single yellow line 'No waiting Monday - Friday 8am - 10am and 2pm - 4pm'	Standing Place
